Although these three gentlemen play together in a band well-known on the German Irish pub scene, each has a solo career which encompasses self-penned songs and music with a provenance well-grounded in the traditional folk idiom. The Irish Folk Club Munich is honoured to present this aspect of their artistry.

Phil Newton comes from Liverpool, the Irish capital of England, and one time home to the Beatles. He has recently released his own personal “White Album” with self-penned songs spanning his musical career.

Hawaii-born Solecki spent much of his childhood in Kansas before emigrating to Ireland where he spent 10 years living in Cork city, Ireland. This amalgam of influences fuelled his interest in bluegrass and Irish music and has left a great imprint on his song writing.

Paul Daly from Dublin, Ireland has had a long and varied musical and business career tightly woven into a rich tapestry depicting the idiosyncrasies and social issues affecting his native country. A fine raconteur who peppers his song presentation with background information.
